

## **Student assistant in CLIMPRO-Bonn project | FAST division**

### **United Nations University – Institute for Environment and Human Security (UNU-EHS)**

The Urban Futures and Sustainability Transformation (FAST) division seeks a highly motivated student assistant with an outstanding record in prior student qualifications, as well as strong methodological skills in quantitative social research methods, in particular surveys. The candidate will support urban research within the team, predominantly the CLIMPRO-Bonn project on “Climate protection and adaptation acceptance and behavior of Bonn households”. Previous experience in working on topics related to urban development and climate change is an additional asset but are not required.

Under the supervision of Dr. Simone Sandholz and in coordination with the project team, the successful candidate will be entrusted with the following **tasks**:

- Contribution to development of a research design and the respective theoretical framework
- Support of questionnaire development and data collection, linking surveys to qualitative data collection methods
- Data management, including cleaning survey data
- Analyzing quantitative survey data using descriptive and advanced statistical methods
- Linking quantitative data analysis and findings to qualitative research and existing literature
- Support of documentation and reporting, including support of subsequent publications and presentations
- In addition, the selected candidate will be asked to support any other tasks that may arise as part of the program

#### **Prerequisites:**

- Enrolled in a Master's program in a field relevant to the project
- Good knowledge of survey design and analysis
- Knowledge of survey tools (Kobo, QuestionPro, ArcGIS survey, ...) and analysis software (Stata/SPSS/R)
- Knowledge or experience in mixed methods research is desirable
- Fluency in spoken and written German and English

#### **Conditions:**

- **Starting date:** Mid of April 2024 (flexible).
- **Hours:** The contract will cover 10-15 hours of work per week, exact time frame will be coordinated with the candidate.
- **Duration:** The initial contract will cover a period of 6 months. There is a possibility for renewal subject to satisfactory work performance. The position is offered as remote work, with occasional visits to UN Campus.
